



Apply to be a DRCLAS Visiting Scholar

OVERVIEW

Visiting Scholars and Fellows are provided shared office space, library borrowing privileges, access to University facilities and events, and opportunities to audit classes and attend seminars in the Faculty of Arts and Sciences and in other Harvard professional schools.

ELIGIBILITY

The DRCLAS Visiting Scholars and Fellows program is open to academics from Latin America as well as Latin Americanist from the US and other parts of the world (scholars). Applications are also accepted from established practitioners, such as visual and performing artists, and policy-makers (fellows). Scholars are expected to hold a PhD.

FUNDING

The residential fellowships cover round-trip travel expenses, emergency-only health insurance coverage (for the foreign Visiting Scholar or Fellow and accompanying immediate family), and a taxable living stipend while at Harvard. Appointments are typically for one or two semesters depending on applicants preference.
