Transcending Borders: International Philosophy Seminar of the Americas (IPSA)

In order to encourage the exchange of ideas and opportunities throughout the Americas, we are organizing a new seminar—**Transcending Borders: International Philosophy Seminar of the Americas (IPSA)**—and cordially invite you to participate. The intention of the seminar is to provide an informal, supportive environment in which researchers can improve their linguistic and presentation skills in a non-native language.

Talks will be given in English by native Spanish speakers and in Spanish by non-native Spanish speakers. The talks will be virtual and will be the first and third Fridays of the month at 2 p.m. Argentina Time (UTC/GMT -3), beginning **September 2023**.

Speakers will have 30 minutes to present, followed by 45 minutes for questions and discussion in the same language as the talk are encouraged, with some flexibility. Speakers are asked to provide slides or a handout to share with the audience one week before the seminar, when possible.

We are intentionally keeping the subject areas broad, but anticipate that most talks will be in the philosophy of mind, mathematics, science, technology and related areas.
